CURRICULUM VITAE

PhDr. Vladimír Špidla Prime Minister of the Czech Republic

Born on April 22, 1951 in Prague, Mr. Špidla completed his secondary education in 1970 to enrol in the Faculty of Arts, Charles University, Prague where he read history and prehistory.

In 1976, he successfully defended his diploma thesis on the subject of the foundation of the Živnobanka financial institution.

He then took up a number of jobs: a worker in the field of preservation of monuments and protection of nature, an archeologist, a wood-processing plant worker, an employee in a dairy and building materials store.

Before 1989, he had never been affiliated to any pollitical party.

In 1990, Mr. Špidla became Vice-Chairman of the Jindřichuv Hradec District National Committee responsible for education, health care, social affairs and culture.

In 1991 - 1996, he served as director of the local labour office. In 1992, he became a member of the the CSSD Social Democratic Party Presidium, in **March** 1997 - its statutory Vice-Chairman, and in **April 2001** - Chairman of the CSSD.

In the Chamber of Deputies, to which he was returned in 1996, he served as Chairman of the parliamentary Social Policies and Health Care Committee.

From July 22, 1998, he held the post of First Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Labour and Social Affairs commissioned by the Government to co-ordinate the departments of labour and social affairs, health care, education, youth and physicial training, environmental affairs and culture.

In **July 2002**, following the results of parliamentary elections, he became Prime Minister of the Czech Republic.

His hobbies include care of historical monuments, cross-country running and diverse outdoor sports. Mr. Špidla is married the second time, he has two children from his first marriage and another two acquired by marriage.
